Mayor White opened the work session and advised the Council, staff and the audience that staff would provide information and explanations about the following items:

ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER.

Mayor Lew White called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

ITEM 2-A. PRESENTATION BY LEGAL COUNSEL OF EXAMPLE PLAN REDISTRICTING THE CITY COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICTS BASED ON 2020 CENSUS DATA.

Gunner Seaquist of Bickerstaff, Heath, Delgado & Acosta ("the Firm") stated that the Firm presented Plan A to the Council. The Firm recommends the proposed Plan will get the single-member council districts below a 10 percent total maximum deviation. He stated that the total population as reflected in the 2020 Census for the City of Lockhart is 14,379, thereby allocating the total population of each single-member district to 3,593 individuals. City District 2 was the heaviest populated and City District 3 was the lowest populated.

There was discussion and drawing scenarios about City Districts 2 and 3.

ITEM 2-B. DISCUSSION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EXAMPLE PLAN AND AMENDMENTS TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR FUTURE ADOPTION.

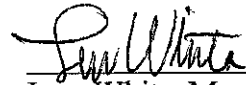
